Ordinance

for

Five-year Integrated B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B./B.Com.LL.B. Professional Degree Course

Applicable from academic session 2012– 2013 onwards

Norms for Admission:

1. A candidate who have passed 10+2 or 11+1 examination of any Board or Indian University incorporated by law for the time being in force with a minimum of 45% marks eligible to seek admission to the First semester course of B.A. LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. A relaxation of 5% marks is admissible to candidate belonging to SC and ST categories of Uttrakhand as per G.O. issued by the Government.

2. Admissions to this course shall generally be made through an entrance test to be conducted by the University. However, in case of unavoidable exigency the university reserve the right to grant permission for making admission purely on merit basis in any academic session. The entrance test for admission to the course shall comprise of following two papers :
 - A- Current affairs & Legal Aptitude
 - B- Language

Each papers shall carry 100 marks and minimum qualifying marks for each papers shall be 40.

3. Admission of students to different semesters in B.A.LL.B/B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. course shall be made by the Dean , Faculty of Law /Principal of the college on the basis of recommendation of the departmental admission committees.
4. If any provision or rule regarding admission contained herein is found to be inconsistent with or in derogation of the prescribed rules of the Bar Council of India , the prescribed rules of the Bar Council of India shall prevail
5. Admission to the course shall be allowed only on full time basis and no student shall be allowed to undertake studies for this course in addition to or with any other full time or part-time course, whether as a regular, private, part-time student or an ex-student. In the event of any student taking admission in some other course, his/her admission to this course shall stand cancelled.
6. The Dean, Faculty of Law, Kumaun University may permit admission through migration of a student from another recognized university to III or V or VII or IX Semester of the course of this University, if the rules of admission and the course structure of course are essentially the same in the two universities and on such further terms and conditions as may be laid down by the Dean.
7. The students shall be required to put in minimum percentage of attendance in classes and also in the moot courts and practical training course as per the rules of University. No candidate shall be allowed to appear in the semester examinations of the course unless he/she has the required percentage of attendance in classes as per rules of the University. Examinations of each semester shall be held at the end of that semesters. The scheme of examination shall be announced by the University.

Examination Regulations:

8. The 5-year integrated B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. professional degree course shall comprise of total 10 (ten) Semesters, with two semesters each year. A student

passing all the ten semester's examinations as per provisions of this Ordinance shall be awarded the degree of B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B.

9. A student who has appeared in the examination of I, III, V, VII or IX semesters of the course shall be automatically promoted to the next semester namely, to the II, IV, VI, VIII or X semesters of the course respectably, subject to other provision of the ordinance. However, such automatic promotion shall only render the student eligible for the examination of the immediately succeeding semesters namely, II, IV, VI, VIII, or X semesters, as the case may be, but shall not effect the actual result of such previous semester.
10. A student who has appeared in 2nd Semester Examination of the course shall be declared 'pass' if he / she fulfils both the following conditions:
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the **ten** papers of the 1st and 2nd Semesters of the course;
- AND
- B- He / She gets 45% marks in aggregate of all those papers in each semesters.
11. The candidate who has appeared in 2nd Semester Examination of the course shall be *eligible to seek admission to 3rd Semester*, if he / she gets at least 36% marks **each** in any eight papers of 1st and 2nd Semesters of the course.
12. The candidate who has appeared in 4th Semester Examination of the course shall be declared **Pass**, if he / she fulfills both the following conditions:-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of all **twenty papers** of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semesters of the course;
- AND
- B- He / She get 45% marks in aggregate of all those papers in each semesters.

13. The candidate who has appeared in 4th Semester Examination of the course shall be *eligible to seek admission to the 5th Semester*, if he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any eight papers of 3rd, and 4th Semesters of the course.
14. The candidate who has appeared in 6th Semester Examination of the course shall be declared **Pass**, if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the **thirty** papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th semesters of the course;
- AND
- B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate of all those papers in each semesters.
15. The candidate who has appeared in 6th Semester Examination of the course shall be *eligible to seek his / her admission to 7th Semester*, if he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any eight papers of 5th and 6th Semesters of the course.
16. The candidate who has appeared in 8th Semester Examination of the course shall be declared '**Pass**', if he / she fulfils the following conditions:-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the **forty** papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Semesters of the course;
- AND
- B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate of all those papers in each Semesters.
17. The candidate who has appeared in 8th Semester Examination of the course shall be *eligible to seek admission to 9th semester of the course*, if he /she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any six theory papers and minimum 45% marks in both the practical papers, prescribed therein in 7th and 8th Semesters of the course.
18. The candidate who has appeared in 10th Semester Examination of the course shall be declared '**Pass**' and awarded division, if he /she fulfils all the following conditions:-
- A- He/she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the **fifty papers** of. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th Semesters of the course;

AND

B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate of all those papers in each Semesters.

AND

C- He/she has successfully completed twenty weeks of internship as prescribed under this Ordinance.

19. The candidate who appears in the Tenth Semester Examination shall be Eligible to Reappear in those papers of the 9th and/or 10th Semester(s) in which he/she has failed, if he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any *six theory* papers and a minimum 45% marks in both the practical papers prescribed therein in 9th and 10th Semesters of the course.

20. Notwithstanding anything contained in the aforesaid provisions, if any candidate fails to secure at least 36% marks in minimum 3 (three) papers in 1st or 2nd or 3rd or 4th or 5th or 6th semester, at least 2 (two) theory papers and/or 45% marks in practical papers in 7th or 8th or 9th or 10th semester, such candidate shall have to repeat that whole semester i.e. shall have to reappear in all prescribed papers of that particular semester in which he/she has failed in passing such minimum number of papers/practical paper.

21. **Maximum Chances to Reappear:** In the entire duration of the course, the maximum number of chances available to any candidate for reappearing in any paper, in which he/she has failed, shall not exceed **two** in any case.

Provided that any student who passes all the individual papers of both semesters of a year of the course, but fails to secure an aggregate of 45% in total in that year, then he/she shall be entitled to reappear in any **two** of these theory papers of his/her choice with the regular examination of the concerned semester(s) in future. The maximum chances for reappearing in such paper(s) shall not exceed **two** in any case.

22. **Scrutiny Facility:** There shall be no re-evaluation or re-checking in any paper in any case. However, a student may duly apply for scrutiny in the prescribed form within 15

days of declaration of his result. The University shall declare his/her result within 30 days of such application. However, mere application to the University for scrutiny in any subject shall not confer any special claim, eligibility or entitlement to such applicant in any regard.

23. Division of Passing: The Division shall be determined on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in all the ten semesters prescribed for five-year integrated B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. degree as under-

- A- First Division - 60% and above
- B- Second Division - 45% and above but below 60%

24. Maximum Marks: Each paper from First to Tenth semester shall carry maximum 100 marks.

25. Maximum Span of the Course: A candidate who does not pass five year B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. integrated course of ten semesters within a period of *ten* years shall cease to be a candidate for the degree. The period of *ten* year shall be reckoned from the academic session in which he / she was admitted to the first semester of B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. five year integrated degree course.

26. Full time course & No mid-course Migration: No student shall be permitted to pursue any degree or diploma course, except any add-on course, of Kumoun University or any other University or institution along with the Five-year Integrated B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. Course and once he/she has taken admission in B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. Course, he/she shall not be allowed to migrate or transfer to any other College/Institute/University for completing the Course.

27. Internship:

All students shall be required to successfully complete each term of internship with any organization/NGO/Body/office etc. (refer to curricula for the detailed list) recognized in writing for the purpose by the Head, Department of Law / Principal, Law

college concerned. Each student shall keep an internship diary in the form stipulated by the Law Department/College, the last pages of which shall contain blank format of the performance report to be filled /issued by the competent officer/authority of such organization /NGO/Body/Office etc. in regard to performance of the student (intern) during internship. This diary, along with such performance report, shall be evaluated internally by the teacher(s) concerned each time. Where the evaluation result is “Satisfactory”, it shall be regarded as successful completion of that term of internship. An evaluation of student’s performance report of his/her internship shall be made at the end of each concerned semester, but total marks for internship shall be assessed only in the Final semester under the prescribed practical paper.

Any student who remains absent or fails to successfully complete the internship prescribed for any semester-end shall have to repeat the same, subject to the condition that no internship at any semester-end shall, jointly or severally, exceed the duration of 30 days.

Notwithstanding anything contained in other provisions of this Ordinance, any student who is unable to successfully complete internship of total 20 weeks during the B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. course as prescribed by the Bar Council of India shall NOT be awarded the degree of B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B/B.Com.LL.B. by the University.

28. Formal Dress Code During Internship and Moot Court :

Students placed under internship or in moot court exercise shall have formal dress of legal professional in pupillage as follows:

- For All : White/Black trouser, White Shirt, Black Tie, Black Coat, Black Shoe and Black Socks.
- Optional for Girl Students: White Kamij/Kurta, White Salwar, White/Black Chunari, Black Coat, or Black Printed Saree with White Blouse and Black Footwear.
