Ordinance

**Five year B.A.,LL.B Integrated Course
Applicable from the academic session 20.... – 20....**

Semester System

1. Five Year B.A., LL.B. integrated course of law after 10+2 or 11+1.
2. The five year B.A., LL.B. integrated course of law after 10+2 or 11+1 shall comprise of two parts viz. Part-I which will be a two year core programme of pre-law study and Part-II which will be a three-year programme for professional training in law.
3. The examination for the degree of five year B.A., LL.B., integrated course shall consist of ten Semesters, examinations to be held every half yearly in five academic years. A student clearing all the ten semesters examinations shall be conferred upon with the degree of B.A., LL.B.
4. A candidate after passing 10+2 or 11+1 examination of any Board or Indian University incorporated by law for the time being in force with such percentage of marks as prescribed by the Bar Council of India and /or University from time to time shall be eligible for admission to the First semester course of B.A., LL.B. provided that his/ her percentage of marks is not less than 40% and in case of S.C./ S.T. is not less than 35% marks.
5. The candidate should satisfy himself/ herself that he/she fulfils the eligibility requirements in terms of educational qualifications and percentage of marks secured by the candidate in the qualifying examination.
6. The students shall be required to put in minimum attendance of 66% of the lectures in each of the subjects and also in the moot courts and practical training course. No candidate shall be allowed to appear in five year B.A., LL.B. integrated course in Second, Fourth, Sixth, Eighth and Tenth semester, unless he/she has put in the required percentage of attendance.
7. The admission under Lateral Entry mode, shall be made against those seats which remained unfilled in the 1st Semester or Subsequently fell vacant during 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Semesters because of drop-outs and /or failures in the preceding Semesters 1 to 4, shall be filled in the 5th semester of 5 year integrated B.A.,LL.B. Course only by the holders of graduates degree of a University established Under Central and /or state law and/or any such other degree considered as equivalent there to by Kumaun University and has been recognized by U.G.C. and also Bar Council of India

Eligibility for Admission to B.A., L.L.B. Course through Lateral Entry Mode:

- A- Subject to compliance with the requirements of the Ordinances and regulations of the University and the norms fixed by the admission Committee, from time to time ,a candidate who is appearing in the final year examination and has passed any one of the following course with a minimum percentage of 40% marks, is eligible to seek admission to B.A.,LL.B. Course [Lateral Entry], and in case of S.C./ S.T. is not less than 35% marks.
- i. A Bachelor’s degree in Arts, Commerce or Science of this University or that of any other University established by law and recognized for this purpose by Kumaun University.
OR
 - ii. M.B.B.S., B.E., B.Sc.(Ag.), B. Tech., B.B.A.,B.C.A. or any other equivalent professional degree of Kumaun University or any other Indian University recognized for this purpose by Kumaun University.
OR
 - iii. Vidyalkar or Vedalkar degree of Gurukul Kangri.
OR
 - iv. Shastri degree of Varanasi Sanskrit University now (Sampurnanand Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya).
8. Candidates seeking admission under lateral entry mode shall be awarded with the degree of LL.B [Lateral Entry].
9. A student who has secured his / her admission through Lateral Entry in the 5th semester of Five Year integrated course of B.A.LL.B. as graduate shall have to pass out his / her 5th, 6th,7th, 8th, 9th and 10th semester papers within a period of 6 years from the date of his/ her admission to 5th semester of B.A., LL.B. integrated Course.
- A- Any student admitted through lateral entry in 5th semester in 5 year B.A.LL.B integrated course, should be required to pass two additional qualifying papers, in addition to the papers specified for the 5th to 10th semester of B.A.LL.B integrated course. The students have to opt any two papers out of the following four papers, subject to the condition that he/she has not studied the opted paper at the Graduation Level:-
- General English
 - Political Science
 - Sociology
 - Economics
10. All admission shall be made on the basis of merit/entrance test.

11. The candidate who has appeared in 2nd Semester Examination shall be declared 'pass' if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:
- A- he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the ten papers of the 1st and 2nd Semesters.
- AND
- B- he / she gets 45%marks in aggregate of all those ten papers.
12. The candidate who has appeared in 2nd Semester Examination shall be eligible to seek admission to 3rd Semester', if he / she fulfils all the following conditions :-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the six papers of 1st and 2nd Semesters.,
- AND
- B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in those six papers of 1st and 2nd Semester examinations.
13. The candidate who has appeared in 4th Semester Examination shall be declared Pass, if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of all eighteen papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semesters.
- AND
- B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in all those eighteen papers.
14. The candidate who has appeared in 4th Semester Examination shall be eligible to seek admission to 5th Semester' , if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any fourteen papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Semesters.
- AND
- B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in all those fourteen Papers.
15. The candidate who has appeared in 6th Semester Examination shall be declared Pass, if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:-
- A- He / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of the twenty eight papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th semesters.
- AND
- B- He / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in all those twenty eight papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th semesters.
 - C- A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode , shall be required to obtain at least 36% marks in each one of the ten papers of 5th and 6th semesters provided the aggregate percentage of marks in those ten papers is 45% and above.
16. The candidate who has appeared in 6th Semester Examination shall be eligible to seek his / her admission to 7th Semester, if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:-

A- He/ she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any twenty four papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th Semesters.

AND

B- He / she get 45%marks in aggregate in all those twenty four papers.

C- A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode, shall be required to obtain at least 36% marks in any seven papers out of ten papers of 5th and 6th semesters provided the aggregate percentage of marks in those seven papers is 45% and above.

17. The candidate who has appeared in 8th Semester Examination shall be declared 'Pass', if he / she fulfils the following conditions:-

A- he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of thirty six theory papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Semesters.

AND

B- He / she get 45% marks in each one of the two Practical Papers of 7th and 8th Semesters.

AND

C- He / she get 45% marks in aggregate in all those thirty eight papers.

D- A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode, shall be required to obtain at least 36% marks in each one of the eighteen theory papers of 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th semesters and 45% in two practical papers of 7th and 8th semesters provided the aggregate percentage of marks in all those twenty papers is 45% and above.

18. The candidate who has appeared in 8th Semester Examination shall be eligible to seek admission to 9th semester, if he /she fulfils the following conditions:-

A- he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any thirty two theory papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Semesters.

AND

B- he / she gets 45% marks in each one of the two practical papers of 7th and 8th Semesters.

AND

C- he / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in all those thirty four papers.

D- A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode, shall be required to obtain at least 36% marks in any fifteen theory papers out of eighteen theory papers of 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th semester provided that the candidate has passed at least two theory papers each in 7th and 8th semesters respectively and 45% in two practical papers of 7th and 8th semesters provided the aggregate percentage of marks in all those seventeen papers including practical papers is 45% and above.

19. The candidate who has appeared in Tenth Semester Examination shall be declared 'Pass' and awarded division, if he /she fulfils the following conditions:-

A- he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of all the forty two papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th Semesters.

AND

- B- he / she gets 45% marks in each one of all the four practical papers of 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th Semesters.

AND

- C- he / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in all those forty six papers.
- D- A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode , shall be required to obtain at least 36% marks in any twenty four theory papers of 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th semesters and 45% in four practical papers of 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th semesters. provided the aggregate percentage of marks in all those twenty eight is 45% and above.

20. The candidate who has appeared in Tenth Semester Examination shall also be declared Eligible to Reappear if he / she fulfils all the following conditions:-

- A- he / she gets at least 36% marks in each one of any Thirty Eight papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th Semesters.

AND

- B- he / she gets 45% marks in each one of all the four practical papers of 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th Semesters.

AND

- C- he / she gets 45% marks in aggregate in all those forty two papers including practical papers.
- D- A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode , shall be required to obtain at least 36% marks in any twenty one theory papers out of twenty four theory papers of 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th semesters and 45% in four practical papers of 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th semesters. provided the aggregate percentage of marks in all those twenty five papers including practical papers is 45% and above.

21. The candidate who has appeared in any semester examinations and could not be declared 'Pass' or 'Eligible For Next Semester', according to the above rules, shall be declared 'Fail'. Such candidate has to reappear in all the papers of relevant semesters as an Ex- Student.

22. Subject to the ordinance of law faculty of Kumaun University, a candidate who does not appear in viva-voce examination or secures less than 45% marks in the practical papers, shall also be declared 'Fail' in the examination of the concerned semester. Such candidate has also to reappear in all the papers of relevant semesters as an Ex-Student.

23. There will be no back paper facility in the examinations of all or in any Semester. However the candidate shall be eligible to clear his / her left out maximum four papers (three papers in case of lateral entry) but not Practical Papers, if any, while appearing in third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth semester examination, as the case may be, those failing to clear ninth and tenth semesters maximum four papers (three papers in case of lateral entry) and not Practical Paper, if any, may appear as an ex-student in those papers next year when ninth and tenth semester examinations are held.

24. The Division shall be determined on the basis of the aggregate marks of all the semesters prescribed for five year B.A., LL.B. integrated degree as under-

25. A candidate shall be required to offer five papers in the first, second, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth semesters, and four papers in third, fourth, ninth and tenth semesters.
26. Each paper up to Fourth Semester shall carry 50 marks from Fifth to Tenth semester each paper shall carry 100 marks.
27. A student who has completed three years of the five years course in law shall be eligible to get a degree of Bachelor of Arts (Laws) from the University on passing six semesters examination, but such degree shall not entitle the student to enroll as an advocate.
28. After completion of the first three years (i.e. up to the 6th semester) of B.A.,LL.B five years integrated course, the mark sheet of the 6th semester shall contain the marks received in all the semester exams till the 6th semester.
29. Those students who seek their admission as holders of graduate degree under lateral entry mode as provided in this ordinance , after completion of three years and passing out all papers prescribed for 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th semesters and also practical training papers including viva-voce of 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th semesters as contained herein above in the ordinance , shall be awarded the degree of Bachelor of Laws [Lateral Entry] only.
30. A candidate who does not pass five year B.A. LL.B. integrated course of ten semesters within a period of eight years shall cease to be a candidate for the degree. The period of eight year shall be reckoned from the academic session in which he / she started studies in the first semester of B.A., LL.B. five year integrated degree course.
31. A candidate who has sought his/her admission to 5th semester as graduate under lateral entry mode, does not pass five year B.A. LL.B. integrated Course of Ten Semesters within a period of six years shall cease to be a candidate for the degree. The period of six year shall be reckoned from the academic session in which he / she started studies in the fifth semester of B.A., LL.B. five year integrated degree course.
32. No student shall be permitted to pursue any diploma course with same teaching hours or any degree course of Kumoun University or any other University or institution along with five year B.A.LL.B. Integrated Course and once he/she has taken admission in B.A.LL.B. integrated Course, he/she shall not be allowed to migrate or transfer for completing the Course to any College/Institute/University.
